You are advised to keep copies of all financial documents submitted to Gardner-Webb University. Similar information will be required by the United States Consular Office when you apply for your visa or by the Immigration and Naturalization Service when you apply for a transfer within the United States.

**NOTE:**

1. Financial resources of a temporary US resident (F-1 or J-1) cannot be considered.
2. Financial aid at Gardner-Webb University is limited; therefore, all graduate students must be prepared to fully support themselves during study at Gardner-Webb University.

I understand and state that Gardner-Webb University is not responsible for my financial support and that I must pay for each semester in full, approximately \$3,500.00, prior to registering for classes.

Students must present written documentation of their ability to read and write the English Language. This requirement can be met by the ELS level 107, Michigan Test Score at the 50 percentile, or a TOEFL score of 500.

The North Carolina state law requires that a new undergraduate and graduate students entering college must have certain required immunizations. Immunization records must be kept on file at the college. Students taking both day and night classes are required to present proof of immunization.
